

All Star Youth Jazz Orchestra

Audition Requirements

This ensemble is audition only.

Candidates should have intermediate to advanced skills on their instrument, equivalent of at least 3 years of experience and at least 1 year experience playing jazz.

- Complete the online audition form. You will be contacted by JazzArts Charlotte staff with an audition time. Auditions are approximately 10 minutes.
- If you cannot make any of the audition dates, we will consider video auditions.
- Musicians who have been accepted into the ensemble will be notified by the staff and given a
 private link to sign up for the Youth Jazz Orchestra.
- Tuition is required to complete enrollment: \$700 annual/ \$350 semester.

You may also audition to be an alternate.

An "alternate" is someone who is not a regular member of the band but will be called upon to sub for a band member at rehearsals, recordings, or performances. Benefits include free concert tickets to select shows, and a standing invitation to observe rehearsals, clinics, and workshops. This program is free of charge.

What to Expect at Auditions

Faculty will be evaluating you based on technique, musicality, sight-reading ability and in some cases, familiarity with jazz language and improvisation. All applicants should be prepared to demonstrate the following.

- 1. Audition piece A link to your instrument-specific piece is found below. Musicians on all instruments will audition unaccompanied.
- 2. Sight Reading will be provided at the time of audition.
- 3. Optional improvisation Blues or Jazz standard of your choice.
- 4. Instrument specific pieces and instructions below.

Horns

Click the following for the audition piece for your instrument: <u>Trumpet</u>, <u>Lead Trumpet</u>, <u>Trombone</u>, <u>Bass</u> <u>Trombone</u>.

Performing a Blues or Jazz Standard with improvise is optional, but highly encouraged.

Trumpet Players: please inform faculty if you are auditioning for the lead trumpet chair. You will be asked to play one or two phrases in the extended range.

Trombone Players: please inform the adjudicators if you are auditioning as bass trombonist.

Saxophone

Performing a Blues or Jazz Standard with improvise is optional, but highly encouraged.

Piano/Guitar

Click here for the piano/guitar audition sheet music.

Be prepared to play the melody, improvise, and comp through the chord changes. Sight-reading will include melody and chord changes.

Guitar and bass amps will be provided. You do not need to bring your own.

Bass

Click here for the acoustic bass audition sheet music.

In addition to the audition piece and sight reading, we would encourage you to walk bass lines on the blues or a jazz standard. This is optional but encouraged.

Drums

Click here for the drums audition sheet music.

In addition to the audition piece and sight reading, be prepared to play examples of the following feels: swing at different tempos (medium, fast, and ballad), Latin, bossa, and funk.

Please bring brushes. A drum kit with cymbals will be provided. You do not need to bring your own. All drummers will play on the same drum and cymbal set-up.

Vocalists

You may sing with a backing track on an mp3 player (no CDs please). Vocalists are not required to take a solo chorus, but are encouraged to do so if they feel comfortable.
